## **EMERGENCY EVACUATION DRILL**

In a continuing effort to optimize Health and Safety standards within the university community, an evacuation drill will take place **on Thursday**, **13 February**, **2019** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> (B') phase building of the University Hall of Residences of the Technical University of Crete. Students in the aforementioned building during the drill are kindly requested to fully cooperate and follow the instructions of university staff. We recognize these drills may interrupt your schedule and apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

Please read the building evacuation instructions below carefully as they are critical in order to ensure the safety of all members of the TUC community in case of an emergency.

- 1. The moment you hear the siren, act immediately.
- 2. Exit the building and follow the escape route.
- 3. While you are on the escape route, do not run; just walk, as if you were in a rush to catch a bus.
- 4. After you leave, do not go back into the building to take any personal belongings (cellphones, wallets, etc.)
- 5. During the exit process, do not shout or speak loudly, and try to remain calm.
- 6. Do not run in the opposite direction of the crowd, even if someone calls you or if you hear your cellphone ringing.
- 7. If someone who is in front of you falls or something else happens to them, do not bypass them; try to help them, otherwise you and/or the person behind you will also fall.
