His work has been published in several countries in America and Europe.

She is a member of the Iberian-American network Proterra from the beginning in the year 2002. She is also a member of the Unesco Cathedra, which deals with earth architectures, constructive cultures, sustainable development. She is currently coordining the training courses given by UTU (University of Labor of Uruguay) in different parts of the country.
