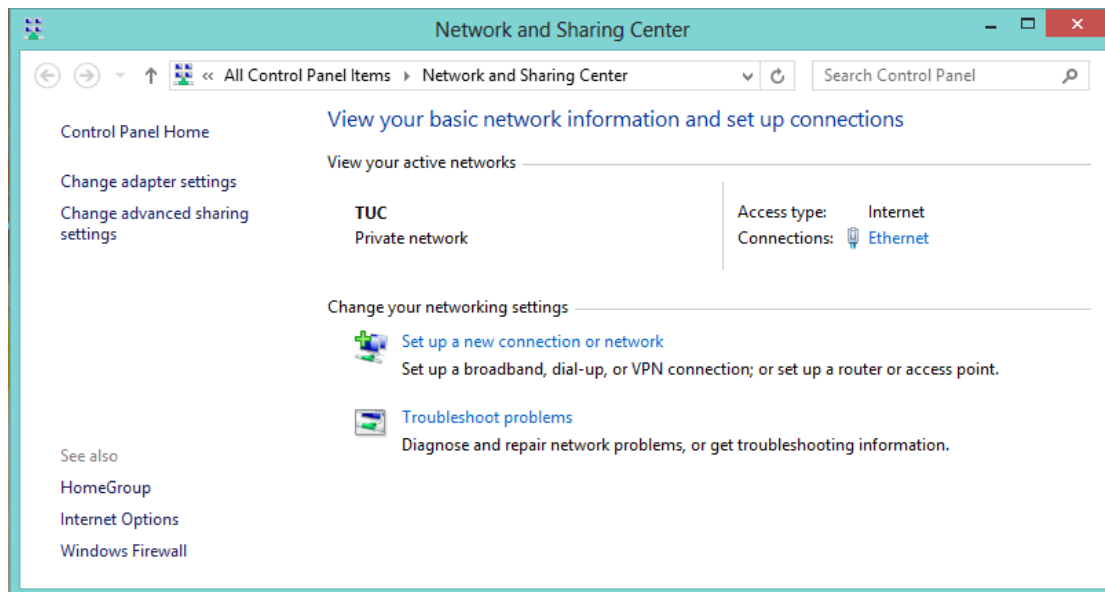
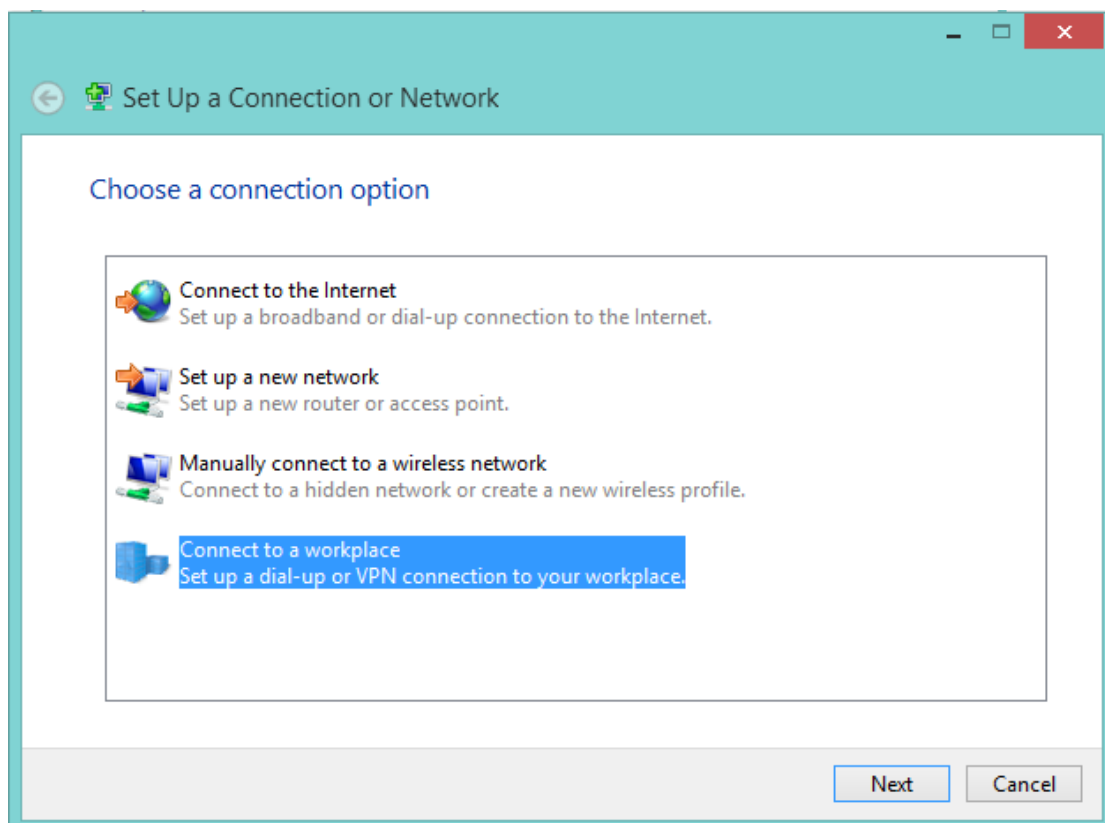


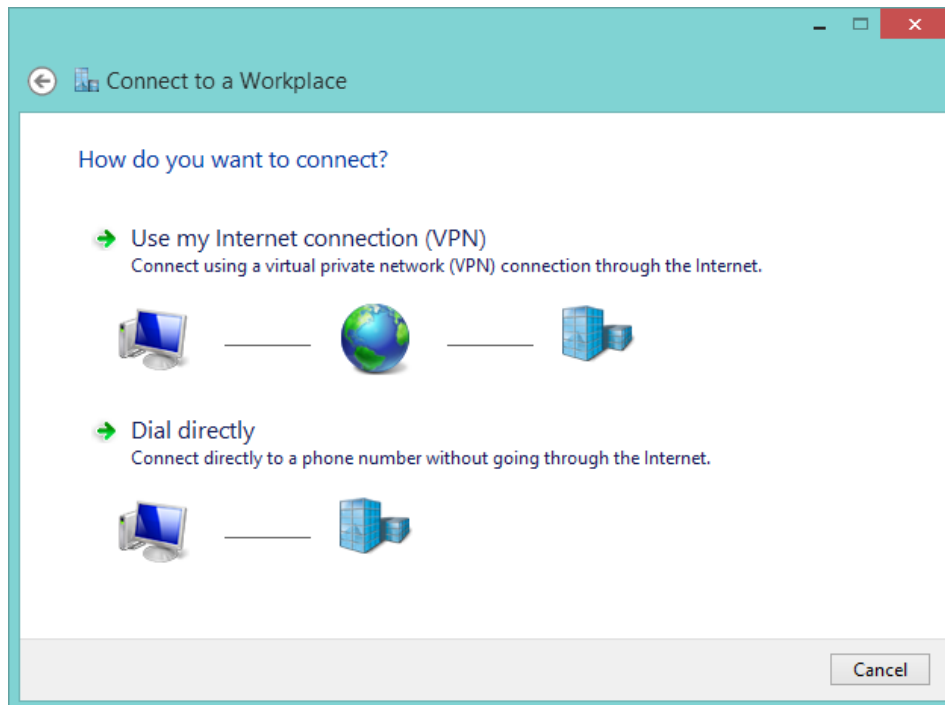
Open **Network and Sharing Center**. You can open it from Control Panel, or right click on Network icon, or search “Network” from Settings Search panel (Win+W):



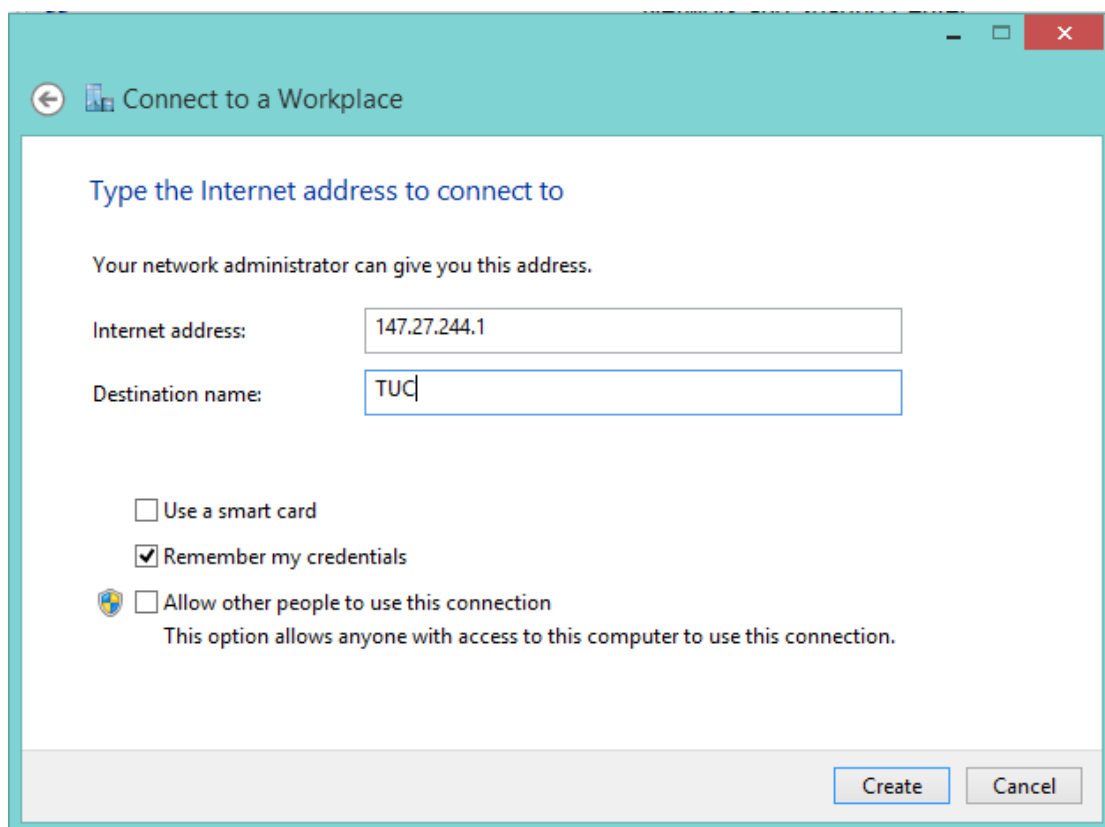
Choose **Set up a new connection or network**.



Choose **Connect to a workplace** (set up a dial-up or VPN connection to your computer) and click Next.



Click on **Use my Internet connection (VPN)**



Type the following:

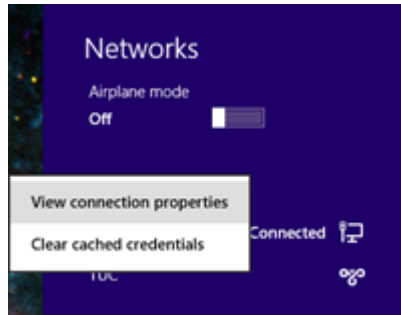
Internet Address: **147.27.244.1**

Click on **Create**.

Click on **Network** icon to see the available networks. Right click the VPN connection named **TUC** and choose **View connection properties**



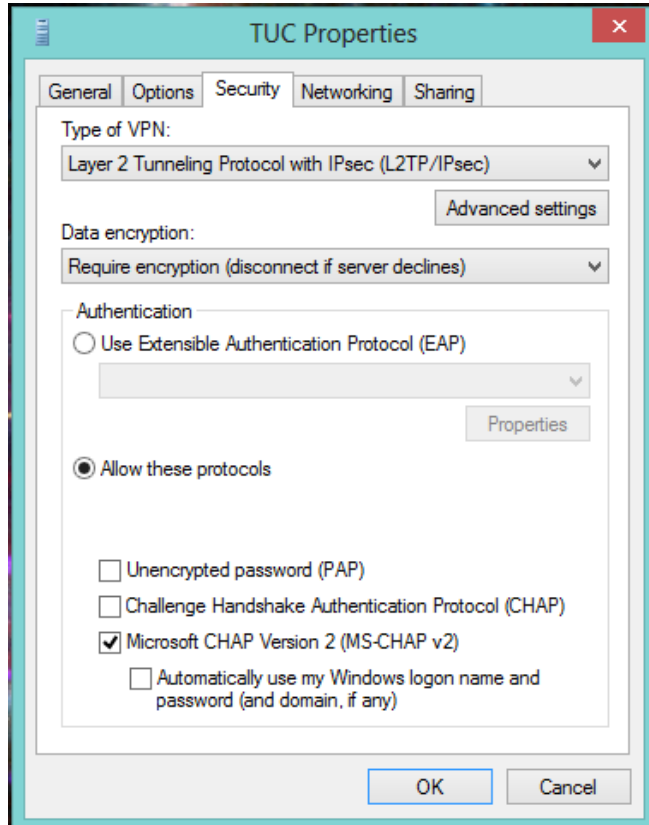
Open **Security** tab and change the following:

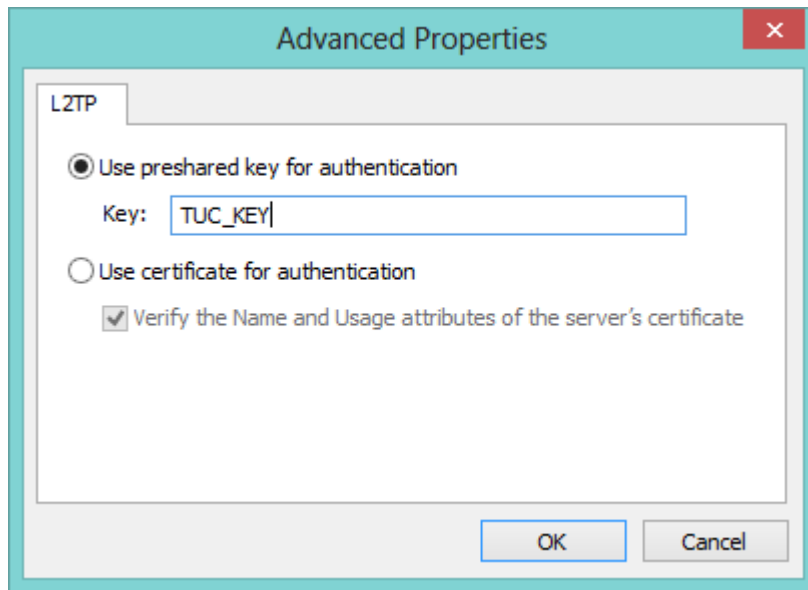
